

Programme of Study for Sex and Relationships

EYFS - God loves each of us in our uniqueness

Children know and understand that God has made them unique and although we are different we are special to him

Year One - We meet God's love in our family

Children know and understand that they are growing and developing as members of their own and God's family.

Year Two - We meet God's love in the Community

Children know and understand that they are growing and developing in a God given community

Year Three – How we live in love

Children know and understand the virtues essential to friendship, eg: loyalty, responsibilities... and experience the importance both of forgiving and being forgiven and of celebrating God's forgiveness.

Year Four – God loves us despite our differences

Children know and understand that they are all different and celebrate these differences as they appreciate that God's Love accepts us as we are and as we change.

Year Five – God loves me in my changing and development

Children know and become aware of the physical and emotional changes that accompany puberty – sensitivity, mood swings, anger, boredom etc. and grow further in their understanding of God's presence in their daily lives.

Year Six – The Wonder of God's love in creating new life

Children develop, in an appropriate way for their age, an understanding of sexuality and grow further in their appreciation of their dignity and worth as children of God
