Supporting your child at home:

Please can you focus on encouraging your child to be as independent as possible in putting on their coat, taking off socks and shoes and modelling how to turn them the correct way around independently. Thank you.

Please reinforce using knives and forks at meal times please. Please sit at tables where possible at this is the expectation in nursery/ school.

Please remember...

All children need a pair of wellies in school at all times.

Please ensure all clothes, shoes and wellies are labelled clearly. Jumpers are very difficult to identify when taken off if not labelled up.

No laces unless your child can tie their own.

Snack money is £1.00 a week

PE kit to be worn on a Friday- nursery will take part in this some weeks.

Please ensure your child has a coat in school at all times

No bags at the moment, please leave a plastic carrier bag in school with spare clothes in.
